New Business

1. Bass Council updates:

- Top 6 will be Sept. 21 at El Cap. Taco truck will be used for food. Council is hoping that each club will donate gift cards or gifts instead of money for the raffle. Our club will donate three \$50 gift cards for tackle warehouse or similar card.
- Crisis house is looking for used blankets, jackets and used clothes. If you want to donate, you can bring your items to DVL and give to Andy.
- April 14th is the Brian Graves tournament.
- Mayor may decide to cut city lake funding by 2% - 5% which will likely result in more lake closure days. What we can do as anglers is use the letter template on the bass council website to send to our city officials and tell them how we feel about this.

2. **Club pictures** – We would like to make a habit of taking more pictures on during tournaments and events. If everyone can try to take more pictures, we can have Jesse collect them to put onto our club social media sites. Scott and Miller know social media experts and will investigate how to promote our club better.
